The yearly drent meeting is a great way for drent owners from Sweden, Norway, the rest of Scandinavia and Europe – or wherever you may live - to get together and exchange experiences. ## **Additional information**

### **Vaccinations**

All participating dogs have to be vaccinated according to the regulations of the Swedish Kennel Club:

Participating foreign dogs must be brought into Sweden in accordance with Swedish import requirements for dogs in relation to rabies vaccinations and (if you travel through Norway only) deworming against tapeworms (echinococcus).

Participating dogs must be vaccinated against distemper as follows:

- Dogs **under** the age of one(1)year: at the age of **at least** ten (10) weeks.
- Dogs **over** the age of one(1)year: the dog must be vaccinated at the age of **at least** ten (10) months, and not more than four (4) years ago.
- First-time vaccination must be carried out **at least** fourteen (14) days **before** the day of the trial, competition and/or show.

In addition, SKK recommends that participating dogs are also vaccinated against parvovirus infection and parainfluenza (kennel cough).

### **Pedigree**

For non-Swedish registered dogs you need to bring the dog's pedigree if you wish to enter at the official tests. Please also enclose a copy of the pedigree when applying for the tests (not the training).

### **Participation Fee**

Training during the week is financed through fees from the participants. You pay 650 SEK per dog handler and 350 SEK per adult without a dog, regardless of how many days or how much you want to participate.
